

Joint Anomalies Committee Report: 2023-2024

The Joint Anomalies Committee (JAC) meets each year to consider applications received by the deadline date for submissions from faculty members or their respective academic administrators. This year we met on 20 June 2024. Each applicant was informed of the JAC’s decision in their particular case via E-mail on 25 June 2024.

A total of 60 eligible applications were received from individual faculty members (one application was ineligible as they have already received an award this collective agreement). As per the collective agreement (Article 31A), an amount of \$152,415 was allocated to the Anomalies Fund for 2023-2024. There was no carry-forward this year.

Of the 60 applications, 34 were granted awards from the Anomalies Fund. The total awarded from the Anomalies Fund for 2023-2024 was \$152,400.32.
